



Leather Furniture Guide

Our Full Grain Leather is carefully handpicked and has a distressed vintage look with natural markings, such as healed scars, scratches and wrinkles. Please note that over time the leather will become more flexible, smooth and lighter on the parts most used., resulting in a nicely aging effect.

Maintenance Tips

- Leather furniture is only to be used indoors & kept in a constant ambient temperature.
- Do not expose leather furniture to UV light.
- Avoid any spillages on the furniture.
- Avoid scratching the furniture and do not use any type of abrasive textile or tools as they will damage the leather or frame.

Please Note

Colour shadings and differences between leather items can appear due to the fact UV light influences the finishing over time, meaning different batches of furniture may have different shades of colour variations.

Cleaning Tips

- To clean the leather and frame, please use a soft dry cotton cloth.
- Should liquid be spilled, we advise lightly dabbing the item with a piece of cloth and let it dry out.
- If you accidentally stain the leather, please note that it will sink through the leather in the course of time and will fade.
- Do not use chemical cleaners or grease on the leather as this will damage its appearance.
