Brush Your Sheepskin

There are different brushes to use depending on the length of the sheepskin. For short-haired sheepskin, a pet brush is recommended for regular brushing to maintain the soft, fluffy appearance. For long-haired Yeti sheepskin, such as our St. Moritz Yeti Armchair a wooden bristle brush is best to restore natural loft and remove knots or tangles.

Cleaning Stains and Marks

To clean stains, use a damp sponge and mild detergent, pat gently with a soft towel to absorb the water, and avoid detergents containing bleach or enzymes. Spot clean stains as soon as possible using a damp sponge and pat gently with a soft towel to absorb the water.
